Scholarship Name	Description	Deadline Month
American Medical Association (AMA) Foundation Scholarships	All scholarships are selected based on academic excellence and financial need. Must be nominated through the medical school dean's office or the dean's designate and currently enrolled in an accredited U.S. allopathic or osteopathic medical school. All nominees must be rising final-year medical student.	February
American Medical Women's Association	AMWA's scholarship and loan program began in 1925 at the Annual Meeting in Atlantic City with two gifts, one of \$1000, and one of \$500. This became the start of the Scholarship Fund. Since then, AMWA has continued every year to support medical students who have been nominated by the association!	September
The American Association for Thoracic Surgery	Medical Diversity Scholarship provides up to \$18,500 per year (for up to 2 years) to support medical students who are planning to pursue a career in cardiothoracic surgery and are from an underrepresented in medicine population (defined by the AAMC)	July
American Society of Hematology	American Society of Hematology (ASH) Minority Medical Student Award Program (MMSAP). The MMSAP provides funding to medical students to engage them in the study of hematology and to help them attain valuable knowledge in the field	July
Association of Black Cardiologists	A nonprofit organization with an international membership of health professionals, lay members of the community (Community Health Advocates), corporate members, and institutional members, dedicated to eliminating the disparities related to cardiovascular disease in all people of color	July
Bagby Scholarship	First- or second-year medical students with a demonstrated interest in family medicine may apply for the Dr. Andrew D. Bagby Family Medicine Scholarship.	April
Chinese American Medical Society	Open to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd year medical students of Chinese descent.	March
Chinese American Physicians Society	Open to all medical students.	April
Cook/Rutledge Fellowship Program	Open to New Jersey Residents	April
Daughters of the American Revolution	Search: Dr. Francis Anthony Beneventi Medical Scholarship, Irene and Daisy MacGregor Memorial Scholarship, Alice W. Roke, Leslie Andree Hanna Medical Scholarship	January
Delta Gamma Fraternity Fellowship	Open to applicants who are initiated members of Delta Gamma and who will be pursuing a graduate/professional degree.	April
Edwards Scholarship Fund	Applicants must be a resident of Boston.	March
Hispanic Health Professions Student Scholarship	The scholarship will feature an award of up to \$5,000 annually for 3 years, as well as individual scholarship awards of \$2,000 each.	September

LGBTQ Heart Scholarship Program	Open to members of the LGBT community.

National Health Service Corps Scholarship	Students pursuing primary care health professions training may be eligible to apply to the National Health Service Corps Scholarship Program (NHSC SP).	December
Centers for Disease Control and Prevention	EIS officers are selected from among highly qualified applicants who are drawn to public health service and interested in practicing applied epidemiology.	May
Pisacano Leadership Foundation	Open to rising 4th year medical students.	
US Dept. of Veteran Affairs Loan Repayment Program	The Specialty Education Loan Repayment Program (SELRP) provides financial assistance to physicians in the form of a loan repayment to recent graduates of an accredited medical or osteopathic school, and are currently enrolled or matched to a residency identified as a shortage by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA).	
Health Professions Scholarship Program	The Army, Navy, and Air Force offer a service scholarship to students who attend medical and dental school programs. If accepted, students receive full coverage of all tuition/fee charges as well as reimbursement of health insurance costs and other related school expenses	
AAMC Health Professions Loan Repayment/Scholarships	Welcome to the State and Federal Loan Repayment, Forgiveness, Scholarship, and Other Programs database. This searchable database provides detailed information about many of the state and federal programs available to medical and other health professions students.	
Southern Medical Association Alliance Scholarship	Open to rising third year medical students who demonstrate financial need.	September

National Medical Fellowships	NMF offers need-based and merit scholarships for students of medicine and other health professions. Deadline dates vary.	
Paul & Daisy Soros Fellowship for New Americans	Up to \$90,000 over a two year period: \$25,000/year for maintenance; up to \$20,000/ for New Americans year for tuition. Applicants must be naturalized citizen or hold a green card, if born in the US, be a child of two immigrant parents, one or both of who are naturalized citizens, have a bachelor's degree or be a college senior in good academic standing, and have a maximum age of 30	October
